"Father, in the name of Jesus,
please make these truths from your Word
about your Holy Spirit
a living reality in our lives!"

• May we listen to the Spirit's voice...

and particularly to the Spirit's voice in the pages of Scripture...

IOHN 14:16, 26 (NIV)

¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and **he will give you another Advocate to help you and be with you forever** — ²⁶ But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

JOHN 15:26 (NIV)

²⁶ "When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father — the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father — he will testify about me.

JOHN 16:7, 12-15 (NIV)

⁷ But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. **Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.**

- ¹² "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. ¹³ But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. ¹⁵ ALL THAT BELONGS TO THE FATHER IS MINE. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you."
- So we pray, "Thank you for sending us the Advocate! Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." (1 SAMUEL 3:9) Teach us about Jesus!

ACTS 15:28 (TNIV)

It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us [to]...

■ So we pray, "Lord, give us keen ears and tender hearts to sense what the Holy Spirit is saying to us!"

HEBREWS 3:7-8 (TNIV)

7 So, as the Holy Spirit says:
 "Today, if you hear his voice,
 8 do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion,

during the time of testing in the wilderness...

■ So we pray, "Lord, we hear your voice today...and we throw our hearts wide open to you!"

ISAIAH 50:4 (NIV)

The Sovereign Lord has given me a well-instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary.

He wakens me morning by morning, wakens my ear to listen like one being instructed.

■ So we pray, "Lord, waken me every morning to teach me. I'm listening! There are SO MANY people who are weary right now! Please give me 'a well-instructed tongue to know the word that sustains the weary.'"
