I found that when a passage of Scripture has been very familiar to me for a long time – such as this passage! – if I will simply **slow down** . . . take my time . . . and read thoughtfully and reflectively, it can become alive to me in new and fresh ways.

Look at the challenges the Psalmist faced in his day. **He sees them everywhere he looks!**

- ³ the fowler's snare the **deadly pestilence**
- ⁵ the terror of night,
- the arrow that flies by day,
- ⁶ the **pestilence** that stalks in the darkness, the **plague** that destroys at midday.
- ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand...

How about you and I? We face a few of these in our own everyday lives, right? We haven't been too worried about "the fowler's snare" or "the arrow that flied by day" — but we know that **"the deadly pestilence"** is gunning for us!

Some of us are struggling with **"the terror of night,"** I'm sure. **Anyone out there struggling with insomnia these days?** So many things to worry about. Our health. Our loved ones. The economy. **Our** own personal "economy"! Our jobs. "INFOR-

MATION OVERLOAD"! Contagious uncertainty, fear, and anger in our communities. Divisive political demagoguery. Conflicting medical and health prognoses. Those last items in v. 6 also ring a bell: **"the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, and the plague that destroys at midday."**

Verse 7 is beginning to hit home for us as well: **"A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand..."** We are saddened at the mindboggling numbers of people who have been exposed to this virus . . . who have contracted it . . . who have been hospitalized . . . who have lost their lives. Who have lost someone they love. Who have lost a job. Who have lost money. Who have lost hope.

And yet.

In the words of David Crowder, "in the middle of the mess, there is MAJESTY."
