WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE ARE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT?

1. God

ISAIAH 64:1-2 (NIV)

¹ Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you!

PSALM 80:14 (NLT)

Come back, we beg you, O God of Heaven's Armies.

Look down from heaven and see our plight.

Take care of this grapevine...

LUKE 3:21-22 (NLT)

One day...Jesus himself was baptized.
 As he was praying, the heavens opened,
 and the Holy Spirit, in bodily form,
 descended on him like a dove.
 And a voice from heaven said,
 "You are my dearly loved Son,
 and you bring me great joy."

ACTS 2 (TNIV)

¹ When the day of Pentecost came,

2. God's Word

EZEKIEL 2:1-3:3 (NLT)

¹ "Stand up, son of man," said the voice. "I want to speak with you."

² The Spirit came into me as he spoke, and he set me on my feet. I listened carefully to his words. ³ "Son of man," he said, "I am sending you to the nation of Israel, a rebellious nation that has rebelled against me. They and their ancestors have been rebelling against me to this very day. ⁴ They are a stubborn and hard-hearted people. But I am sending you to say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says!'

⁷ You must give them my messages whether they listen or not. *But they won't listen,* for they are completely rebellious! ⁸ Son of man, *listen to what I say to you.* Do not join them in their rebellion. **Open your mouth, and eat what I give you.**"

⁹ Then I looked and saw a hand reaching out to me. It held a scroll, ¹⁰ which he unrolled.

³ The voice said to me, "Son of man, eat what I am giving you — eat this scroll! Then go and give its message to the people of Israel."

² So I opened my mouth, and he fed me the scroll.

EZEKIEL 36:25-27 (NLT)

25 "...I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean.

Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols.

26 And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you.

I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart.

27 And I will put my Spirit in you so that you will follow my decrees and be careful to obey my regulations.

ACTS 2:4, 11 (TNIV)

⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak <u>IN OTHER LANGUAGES</u> as the Spirit enabled them.

⁵ [and the visitors from every nation under heaven said,]

¹¹ "we hear them DECLARING THE WONDERS OF GOD
IN LANGUAGE WE CAN UNDERSTAND!"

ROMANS 8:11 (MSG)

¹¹ It stands to reason, doesn't it, that if the alive-and-present God who raised Jesus from the dead moves into your life, he'll do the same thing in you that he did in Jesus, **bringing you alive to himself?** When God lives and breathes in you (and he does, as surely as he did in Jesus), you are delivered from that dead life. **With his Spirit living in you,** your body will be as alive as Christ's!

1 CORINTHIANS 14:24-25 (NLT)

²⁴ ...if all of you are prophesying, and unbelievers or people who don't understand these things come into your meeting, they will be convicted of sin and judged by what you say. ²⁵ As they listen, their secret thoughts will be exposed, and **they will fall to their knees and worship God**, declaring, "God is truly here among you."
