GALATIANS 5:1-26 (TNIV)

¹ It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. *Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.*

¹³ You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; *rather, serve one another humbly in love*. ¹⁴ For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵ *If you keep on biting and devouring each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.*

¹⁶ So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature.

¹⁹ The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; ²⁰ idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions ²¹ and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴ *Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires.* ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

Grace and peace to you from God our Father & the Lord Jesus Christ, *who gave himself for our sins to RESCUE us* from the present evil age...

GALATIANS 3:13-14 (NIV)

¹³ Christ REDEEMED us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." [DEUT. 21:23] ¹⁴ He REDEEMED us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

GALATIANS 4:3-7 (NIV)

³ So also...*we were in slavery* under the elemental spiritual forces of the world. ⁴ But when the set time had fully come, **GOD SENT HIS SON**, born of a woman, born under the law, ⁵ **TO REDEEM THOSE** under the law, **THAT WE MIGHT RECEIVE ADOPTION TO SONSHIP**. ⁶ **Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father."** ⁷ **So you are no longer a slave, BUT GOD's CHILD;** and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.
