## ECCLESIASTES 3:1-15 (TNIV) <sup>1</sup> THERE IS A TIME FOR EVERYTHING, AND A SEASON FOR EVERY ACTIVITY UNDER THE HEAVENS:

<sup>2</sup> a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot, <sup>3</sup> a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build, <sup>4</sup> a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance, <sup>5</sup> a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain, <sup>6</sup> a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away, <sup>7</sup> a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak, <sup>8</sup> a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.

<sup>9</sup> What do workers gain from their toil? <sup>10</sup> I have seen the burden God has laid on the human race. <sup>11</sup> He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.

<sup>12</sup> I know that there is nothing better for people than to [rejoice] and to do good while they live. <sup>13</sup> That each of them may eat and drink, and find satisfaction in all their toil — THIS IS THE GIFT OF GOD.

<sup>14</sup> I know that everything *God* does will endure forever; nothing can be added to it & nothing taken from it. GOD DOES IT SO THAT PEOPLE WILL FEAR HIM. [NASB: so that people will "be in awe before Him"] [THE VOICE: "We humans can only stand in awe of all God has done."] **HOW WE CAN SURVIVE OUR "SEASONS"** 1. In the middle of life's but "seasons". v. 11a "God has made everything beautiful in its time": But how can we learn to **SEE** the beauty in our seasons? We can learn to... **EXPECT** them... **DETECT** them... **NAVIGATE** them. How can we learn to NAVIGATE our seasons & see the beauty in them? 2. ...we can still ENJOY God's , everyday <sup>12</sup> I know that there is nothing better for people than to be happy [NASB: "to **rejoice**"] and to do good while they live. 13 That each of them may eat and drink. and find satisfaction in all their toil — THIS IS THE GIFT OF GOD! (a) !— "I know that there is nothing better for people than to rejoice" ECCLESIASTES 2:24-26 (NIV) <sup>24</sup> A person can do nothing better than to **eat and drink** and **find** satisfaction in their own toil. This too, I see, is from the hand of God, <sup>25</sup> for without him, who can eat or find enjoyment? <sup>26</sup> To the person who pleases him, God gives wisdom, knowledge and joy...
