BATTLE ZONE: “Shout of Victory”



“I Can SHOUT For Victory If I Don’t Give Up!”



“So let’s not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don’t give up.” – Galatians 6:9

READ:

Joshua 6

DISCUSS:

- Who was the leader of the Israelite Army?
- What city did God tell Joshua to destroy?
- How many times did Joshua and the army march around the wall on the last day?
- What happened to the walls of Jericho when the Israelites shouted?

SAY:

We are often faced with difficult, and even impossible, circumstances. Sometimes, the enemy, Satan, tries to trick us and make us feel discouraged when we’re faced with those tough times. Sometimes he will try to make us think God isn’t able to or doesn’t want to help us out. Then, we quit.

We know that God has already won the victory and defeated the devil, so we shouldn’t be discouraged and afraid of what will happen when we’re faced with tough times. Instead, we should be patient through our battles and SHOUT about the victory we know we have with God on our side.

When we remember that God sent His Son, Jesus, to defeat the devil and win the ultimate victory, that should cause us to SHOUT for victory!

PRAY:

Pray that your children will not grow tired of doing good but will shout even before they see the victory because they have faith and know that God has already won the victory!
