1. WHY DID GOD GIVE US SO

DEUTERONOMY 6:20-21, 23-25 (TNIV) ²⁰ In the future, when your children ask you, "What is the meaning of the stipulations, decrees and laws the LORD our God has commanded you?" ²¹ tell them: "We were slaves of Pharaoh in Egypt, but the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand. ²³ But he brought us OUT from there to bring us IN and **give** us the land that he promised on oath to our ancestors [GEN. 17:7-8]. ²⁴ The LORD commanded us to **obey** all these decrees and to fear the LORD our God, so that we might always prosper and BE KEPT ALIVE, as is the case today. ²⁵ And if we are careful to obey all this law before the LORD our God, as he has commanded us, that will be our righteousness."

Our *righteousness* is <u>the obedient</u> <u>response that flows from the gratitude</u> of those enjoying liberty, life, & well-being as God's gift." CHRISTOPHER J.H. 2. GOD WANTS US TO

WHAT HE HAS TAUGHT US.

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DEUTERONOMY 6:4-9 (TNIV) ⁴ HEAR, O ISRAEL: THE LORD *OUR* GOD, THE LORD IS ONE. ⁵ LOVE THE LORD *YOUR* GOD WITH *ALL* YOUR HEART AND WITH *ALL* YOUR SOUL AND WITH *ALL* YOUR STRENGTH. ⁶ THESE COMMANDMENTS THAT I GIVE YOU TODAY ARE TO BE <u>ON YOUR HEARTS</u>. ⁷ Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you *sit* at home and when you *walk* along the road, when you *lie down* and when you *get up*. ⁸ Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. ⁹ Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

CHRISTOPHER WRIGHT: "The first misconception is that OT law was a matter of **legalistic conformity** to an external code. On the contrary, Deuteronomy 6:6 is part of a strong stream of OT teaching that calls for the internalizing of the law in the heart, i.e., at the center of a person's mind, will, and character (cf. 4:9; 10:16; 11:18; Jer. 4:4; 31:33; Ezek. 18:31; 36:26f.) CHRIS WRIGHT 100.

DEUTERONOMY 8:2-5 (TNIV) ² **REMEMBER** how the LORD your God **led** *you* all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to **humble** and <u>**TEST**</u> *you in order* <u>TO KNOW WHAT WAS IN YOUR HEART,</u> *whether or not you would keep his commands.*

³ He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your ancestors had known, to <u>TEACH</u> you that people do not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.

⁴ Your clothes did not wear out and your feet did not swell during these forty years. ⁵ Know then <u>in your heart</u> that as a man <u>DISCIPLINES</u> his son, so the LORD your God <u>DISCIPLINES</u> you.
